

Prof. Yi FAN is an Associate Professor (with tenure) in the Department of Real Estate, Business School, National University of Singapore (NUS). Her research focuses on social sustainability and environmental sustainability, and has been published at leading international journals, such as *Nature Climate Change*, *Nature Cities*, *American Economic Journal: Economic Policy*, *Review of Finance*, *Journal of Urban Economics*, *Applied Energy*, *Journal of Environmental Economics and Management*. Yi is currently the Co-Editor of *Labour Economics* (official journal of the European Association of Labour Economists, Q1 in Economics by Journal Impact Factor 2024) and was a Guest Editor of *Renewable & Sustainable Energy Reviews* (Q1 in Green & Sustainable Science & Technology by Journal Impact Factor 2024). She is the recipient of a number of local and international awards on research and teaching, including Homer Hoyt Best Paper Award 2023 (single award), competitive NUS Humanities and Social Sciences Faculty Research Fellowship 2022, and NUS Business School Teaching Excellence Award 2021. She has been leading/participating in 7 Research Grants under Singapore Ministry of Education or National Natural Science Foundation of China, totaling around S\$1.56 million.

Yi is an affiliated researcher at the Institute of Real Estate & Urban Studies and Sustainable and Green Finance Institute at NUS, and an affiliated Fellow of the World Inequality Database. Her opinions have been circulated by international and national organizations, such as *World Bank*, *United Nations*, and *Ministry of National Development Singapore*. Her work has been widely featured by international and local media, such as *The Economist*, *VoxChina*, *Bloomberg*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Straits Times*, and *Channel News Asia*. Yi has been ranked as the global Top 7% Female Economists (based on past 10 years' publications) by IDEAS RePEc.
